PreK - University

Program lengths and topics are flexible for your class' learning goals.

PreK - 1st Grade (~25 minutes)

"The brass are behaving like animals!"

Sometimes, it's a zoo with Brass Over Bridges, and they seem to be acting more like animals than musicians. Hear two cats woo each other, a huge elephant that tries very hard to be graceful, and a beautiful floating swan that effortlessly glides through water.

2th-5th Grade (~40 minutes)
